In the letter entitled "Notice of Pending Suspension" you were provided, the specifics of the above listed violations. In addition, you were provided your right to request a Due Process Review (Skelly Meeting) of this matter, which you did not exercise.

This incident may serve as basis for a substandard evaluation, and/or denial of promotion and/or transfer. Also, be advised that any future sustained incident of a similar nature may result in a substandard performance evaluation, more severe discipline being imposed upon you, up to and including termination, and/or the denial of promotion and/or transfer.

You have the right to appeal, pursuant to Article X, Section 3C and Article XI, Sections 7 & 8 of the Memorandum of Understanding, County of Orange and the Association of Orange County Deputy Sheriff's for the Peace Officer and Supervising Peace Officer Unit.



You are hereby notified that the Orange County Sheriff-Coroner Department ("OCSD") intends to suspend you without pay from your position as a Deputy Sheriff II, for a period of twelve (12) working hours. Your suspension shall be served in its entirety over consecutive days and will be completed within one pay period. Pursuant to Article X, Section 3, of the County of Orange Memorandum of Understanding for the Peace Officer Unit, and the Orange County Sheriff's Department Policy Manual 340.2 (a) 2, you will be suspended for violating the following:

1. OCSD POLICY SECTION 1018.1 - STANDARD OF CONDUCT

Members shall conduct their private and professional lives in such a manner as to avoid bringing discredit upon themselves or the department.

2. OCSD POLICY SECTION 1018.5 - PERFORMANCE OF DUTY

Members shall perform their duties as required or directed by law, department rules/regulations, procedures, policies or by order of a superior officer. All lawful duties required by competent authority shall be performed promptly as directed.

3. OCSD FIELD OPERATIONS MANUAL (FOM), SECTION "19 V C. 4" – EVIDENCE

C. Collection

4. Once you have collected the item, retain physical control over it until it is booked in the evidence locker. Property and evidence WILL be secured in an authorized Property/Evidence locker by the end of shift. (Placing items in an employee locker or in your personal vehicle for temporary storage is strictly prohibited). Under extenuating circumstances, a supervisor may authorize temporary storage in an authorized secure area (example: locked office safe, closet or file cabinet) if that area is only accessible by the deputy or the supervisor. This will maintain chain of custody.

On January 23, 2019, at the direction of Assistant Sheriff Briggs, Internal Affairs initiated a personnel investigation into your on-duty actions relating to improper collection and booking of evidence. An audit was conducted into your collection and booking of evidence from February 2016 to January 2018. The audit revealed you booked evidence late on twenty eight (28) different incidents and four (4) of your cases

had missing evidence. During your interview with Internal Affairs Sergeants Mauga and Weidenkeller, you admitted to booking evidence for these cases late and you had no valid excuse for doing so.

Specifically, Internal Affairs Sergeants spoke to you about DR 17-022090 where the defendant plead guilty on 06-09-17 for Penal Code section and Health and Safety Code section 11364(a) and received 180 days in jail with no term probation. You apparently booked the evidence for this case on 07-16-17, which was thirty seven (37) days later, and after the case was adjudicated. You said the evidence had slipped down into your patrol bag and you lost track of it causing it to be booked in late.

Internal Affairs Sergeants asked you about DRs 16-203093, 16-205670, and 16-220214 where you stated in your reports you booked photographic CDs but they were not in evidence. Instead, the photographs were embedded in your reports. You thought you were being "ingenious" by embedding the photos into the reports. You thought by embedding the photos into the reports it met the evidentiary requirements. You said you should have written in your report that you embedded the photographs instead of stating you booked the CDs into evidence. You said you didn't know what you did with the CDs but you presumed you had thrown them away.

Internal Affairs Sergeants asked you about DR 17-015681 where you stated in your report you booked in a CD but there was no CD booked into Remedy, nor was there any photographs embedded in your report. You said the victim was going to provide you with a CD and you prepared your report in anticipation of receiving these photographs. You said the victim no longer desired prosecution and they never provided the photographs related to the incident. You wrote in your report that you had received the photographs even though you had not. You recognized and acknowledged that you made a mistake by leaving the inaccurate statement in your report. You also clarified that you were not trying to hide anything.

During your interview with Internal Affairs Sergeants, you admitted to consistently booking in evidence late as well as practicing poor chain of custody procedures. You said you would hold onto evidence to investigate the incident further and sometimes you would provide investigations with the evidence.

You also told Sergeants Mauga and Weidenkeller you understood the potential liability issues to yourself and the department because you mishandled evidence. Sergeant Mauga asked you to read the following policies out loud; Canon of Ethic 1001.2, Policy 1019.11, Policy 1018.5, Field Operations Manual 19(v)(c)(4). You said you believed you violated these policies but you didn't intend to violate them.

As a member of the Orange County Sheriff's Department, you have an unyielding responsibility to continually conduct yourself professionally, honestly, and not bring public embarrassment or liability upon yourself, your Department, or its members. After consideration of all available information, the Department believes you violated the above listed OCSD Policy sections.

In addition to this "Notice of Pending Suspension," you are entitled to the documents that substantiate the decision to suspend you:

- Initial Action
- Investigative Summary
- Initiating Memos
- CD of Internal Affairs Interview

This incident may serve as basis for a substandard evaluation, and/or denial of promotion and/or transfer.

Also, be advised that any future sustained incident of a similar nature may result in a substandard performance evaluation, more severe discipline being imposed upon you, up to and including termination, and/or the denial of promotion and/or transfer. You are entitled to a due process review (Skelly Meeting) before discipline is imposed. You may respond in writing to Assistant Sheriff Jon Briggs within ten (10) calendar days of receipt of this notice, or you may request a meeting. If you choose a meeting, you must notify Internal Affairs Sergeant Ehren Weidenkeller within ten (10) calendar days of receipt of this notice and a meeting will be arranged for at later date.

If you do not provide a written response or request a meeting by 1700 hours on the tenth calendar day following your receipt of this notice, it will be assumed you have waived your right to be heard. If you do respond, consideration will be given to your response prior to taking any proposed action on this proposal for suspension. You are entitled to represent yourself or may be represented by the Association of Orange County Deputy Sheriffs ("AOCDS") pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding between the County of Orange and AOCDS in any pre-disciplinary meeting you may request.

If this proposed action becomes final, you have the right to appeal, pursuant to Article X, Section 3C and Article XI, Sections 7 and 8 of the Memorandum of Understanding, County of Orange and the Association of Orange County Deputy Sheriff's for the Peace Officer and Supervising Peace Officer Unit.

INITIAL ACTION

On March 22, 2018, Assistant Sheriff Bill Baker, Internal Criminal investigation into the on-duty actions of Deputy Cary Buechler. It is alleged Buechler mishandled evidence between February 16, 2016, and January 7, 2018 which resulted in evidence being booked late and/or not being booked at all.

On January 21, 2019, The Orange County District Attorney’s office declined to file criminal charges against Buechler.

On January 23, 2019, after the completion of the Internal Criminal investigation and DA review, Assistant Sheriff Briggs recommended an Internal Affairs investigation regarding any violations of Department policies.

Beginning on February 2, 2018, an internal audit was conducted of the department's Property Evidence System. During the course that audit, it was revealed that Deputy Cary Buechler had failed to book a piece of evidence in accordance with Field Operations Manual, Section 19, which states that "Property and evidence will be secured in an authorized Property/Evidence locker by the end of shift. (Placing items in an employee locker or in your personal vehicle for temporary store is strictly prohibited)".

On June 7, 2017, Deputy Buechler arrested a subject on several charges (DR#17-022090). She collected a box cutter and glass smoking pipe as evidence. The subject pled guilty to the charges on June 9, 2017. Dep. Buechler did not book the evidence used in support of the charges until July 16, 2017, thirty-one days after it had been collected and twenty-nine days after the subject pled guilty.

I am requesting an internal investigation into the actions of Deputy Cary Buechler.

CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION

On March 22, 2018, Investigator D. Taylor conducted a criminal investigation into the mishandling of evidence by Deputy Buechler. This investigation was initiated due to an internal audit of the department's Property Evidence System and Buechler was found to have numerous cases where she booked in evidence late.

The following except(s) was taken from Deputy Taylor's criminal investigative report (18-012565):

During the course of that audit, it was revealed Deputy C. Buechler #2153 had failed to book evidence in accordance with Field Operations Manual, Section 19, which states that "Property and evidence will be secured

in an authorized Property/Evidence locker by the end of shift. (Placing items in an employee locker or in your personal vehicle for temporary storage is strictly prohibited)".

Using Sheriff's software applications, I located 431 case numbers in which Deputy Buechler is the assigned deputy. I identified sixty-eight (68) case numbers under which Deputy Buechler collected evidence. I then collected Property Tracking Reports using Remedy. I compared the dates when evidence was booked with the dates it was collected. I then checked court records for each case to determine whether the suspect pled guilty before Deputy Buechler booked in her evidence. I compiled my findings into the below table; the highlighted section is the incident in question and red font indicates discrepancies identified with the evidence booking process compared to reports. The notes section of the table contains language from Deputy Buechler's reports regarding when the evidence was to be booked as well as other notes.

- **DR 17-022090:** Deputy Buechler was dispatched to a call reference a male who appeared to be under the influence of narcotics on Wednesday, June 7, 2017. Deputy Buechler made contact with the suspect who then

fled on foot. The suspect was later apprehended and arrested for CPC 148(a)(1) and outstanding bench warrants for court case ██████████ - H&S 11364(a), court case ██████████ - CPC 466, and court case ██████████ - CPC 594(a). ██████████ was transported and booked into the Orange County Jail Intake Release Center under booking number ██████████ Deputy Buechler wrote a crime report charging Porras with CPC 148(a)(1) and H&S 11364.1(a). Deputy Buechler wrote in her report, "I later booked the methamphetamine pipe, ID's, box cutter, and jewelry at the Yorba Linda Police Station." Report was dated 6/7/17 and signed by Dep. C. Buechler #2153.

On June 9, 2017, ██████████ pled guilty to both charges along with other charges from previous cases relating to court cases ██████████ received 180 days with credit for 6 days (3 actual and 3 conduct). District Attorney Mike Flory was assigned the case. ██████████ was released from custody September 7, 2017.

The Property Tracking Report for this case lists the following property as being placed in evidence by "guest" on July 16, 2017. This was thirty-nine (39) days after the arrest and thirty-seven (37) days after ██████████ pled guilty.

1. Glass methamphetamine pipe (OS17-022090.1)
2. Cal ID to ██████████ knife//misc costume jewelry (OS17-022090.2)

- **DR 17-015681:** On April 4, 2017, Deputy Buechler was dispatched to a call reference CPC 484-488 at the Laguna Woods Golf Pro Shop. The suspect walked out of the Golf Shop carrying a golf club without purchasing it. Deputy Buechler's report states, ██████████ provided me a copy of the video surveillance tape on my OCSD email and I later made a copy and booked it in evidence." Deputy Buechler's report is dated 4/24/17. On 5/2/17, Deputy Carrington #895 wrote a Follow-up report stating he spoke with the victim who explained the golf club had been returned and they did not want to prosecute. The Case Clearance Report dated 7/5/17 by Inv. Olszynski #5477 stated the victim no longer desired prosecution. As of 3-28-18, there is no evidence booked or located in BMC Remedy. On Friday, April 20, 2018, I contacted Elizabeth Bedolla with OCCL and she confirmed there were no photographs/video CD's submitted to their office. They do not have any photographs/video associated with this case number.

- In three cases, Deputy Buechler described in her reports the evidence (photographs) was booked. On Friday, April 20, 2018, I contacted Elizabeth Bedolla with OCCL and she confirmed there were no photographs/ CD's submitted to their office and they do not have any images/ photographs associated with these case numbers. The cases did not list any suspect(s) and have not been filed with the District Attorney's Office. The original reports have pictures embedded within the narratives. The following cases do not have evidence booked via Remedy:

CRIMINAL INTERVIEW OF DEPUTY BUECHLER BY INVESTIGATOR D. TAYLOR AND SERGEANT J. MONTANO

On April 26, 2018, at about 1109 hours, Sergeant J. Montano and I interviewed Buechler in an office at the AOCDS building (1600 N. Main Street, Santa Ana). Attorney Bob Gazley was present with Deputy Buechler. I recorded the interview and the following is a summary. For further details, refer to the recording of the interview. 20 I read Buechler her Miranda Rights from my department issued form. Buechler answered "Yes" to all four questions. I explained to Deputy Buechler there was an audit conducted on the Sheriffs Evidence Booking System. The audit covered all personnel that held the rank of Deputy or Investigator during the time frame of February 1, 2016 to February 1, 2018. During the audit, it was discovered that some evidence had been booked after the criminal case was adjudicated. One or more of her case(s) fell into this category. I explained that any and all reports assigned to her for the time frame (2-1-16 to 2-1-18) were read and compared to the Evidence Booking System to ensure they matched. During the review, I discovered some discrepancies.

Buechler could not recall specifics about the evidence in this case but stated that typically evidence is secured in her patrol bag which is locked in her patrol vehicle. When she does not retain possession of her patrol vehicle for the following day, Buechler will transfer her patrol bag (containing evidence) into her personal vehicle and occasionally transfer her patrol bag into her private residence. Buechler reaffirmed she collected the evidence listed in this case on the date of the incident and she was the only person with access to it until it was booked.

Sergeant J. Montano asked Buechler about the time disparity in booking evidence from the sixty-eight (68) times she collected / booked evidence. Buechler stated she has realized on a couple occasions that evidence slipped down between papers and other contents in her patrol bag and she forgot about it due to being busy. There were also times where she has provided the evidence to Investigator's but did not document it in her report.

I asked Buechler about DR# 17-015681 where she was dispatched to a call reference CPC 484-488 at the Laguna Woods Golf Pro Shop on April 4, 2017. The suspect walked out of the Golf Shop carrying a golf club without purchasing it. Buechler's report states, [REDACTED] provided me a copy of the video surveillance tape on my OCSD email and I later made a copy and booked it in evidence." Buechler's report is dated the same day as the call, April 24, 2017. On May 2, 2017, Deputy Carrington #895 wrote a Follow-up report stating he spoke with the victim who explained the golf club had been returned and they did not want to prosecute.

Buechler said she remembered the call and writing the report before she would have receive the email. Buechler's intention when writing the report was that she would book the video when she received the email. The victim said he would email her the video but Buechler does not remember if the email was ever sent / received. Buechler also stated she does not remember if someone contacted her about the case being inactive due to the victim refusing to prosecute or if she could have possibly deleted or not booked the video due to this circumstance. Buechler stated in this type of situation, she typically downloads an email containing video to her Orange County Sheriff's Department "H drive" then deletes the email. Buechler does not typically save the video on her computer after she downloads it and is uncertain if she currently has video for this case. Buechler said she would look through her "Hdrive" for the video and would contact me if the video was located.

I asked Buechler about case numbers 16-203093, 16-205670, and 16-220214. These three cases listed photographs that were collected and booked as evidence. In all three cases, no photographs were located in Remedy or the OCCL database but were located embedded within the narrative of the report.

DR#16-203093 (3) Color photographs of propane tank cage and cut lock
DR#16-205670 (1) Color photograph of stolen diamond wedding ring
DR#16-220214 (1) Photograph of victim's City Touring bicycle

Buechler described her procedure when receiving or taking photographs as evidence. Buechler stated she either submits a compact disc containing photographs to the Crime Lab evidence locker (mail slot) or submits hard copies of photographs as evidence through Remedy. Buechler also stated she sometimes includes photographs in the narrative of her reports depending on how she receives the photograph(s) evidence.

I showed Buechler a copy of all three reports. Buechler did not remember these cases but said she assumed that embedding the picture(s) in the reports would suffice as booking evidence. Buechler claimed the confusion was probably due to poor writing or semantics on her part. Buechler said she will write more detailed in the future to avoid confusion.

Buechler ended the interview by stating she does not have or know of any evidence not currently booked relating to any current or past cases.

INTERNAL AFFAIRS INVESTIGATION

INTERNAL AFFAIRS PRINCIPAL INTERVIEW

Deputy District Attorney Susan Laird provided a Sheriff's Department with Buechler's case where a defendant served jail time when material evidence was booked late after the defendant pled guilty. The total number of cases for Buechler was one (1) and our investigation concurred with this finding. The District Attorney's office sent out a letter to the defendant affected by Buechler's case. The following is the affected case:

DR 17-022090 – On 06/09/17, the defendant plead guilty in this case to a violation of Penal Code Section 148(a) and Health and Safety Code section 11364(a) and received a sentence of 180 days in jail with no term probation. The evidence was booked on 07/16/17.

Interview of Deputy Cary Buechler/Representative Robert Baumann – July 12, 2019/0926 Hours
Second Interviewer – Sergeant Ehren Weidenkeller

I interviewed Deputy Cary Buechler at the Internal Affairs office. Prior to conducting the interview, I provided her with the Confidentiality Directive, Miranda Advisement, and the Lybarger Admonishment. Buechler acknowledged she understood all the information provided and stated she had no questions.

The interview was digitally recorded. Below is a summary written to provide clarity and may not be in the chronological order of the actual interview. Refer to the recording for additional details.

Deputy Buechler has been employed by the Sheriff's Department for approximately 29 years. Buechler is currently assigned to patrol in the city of Laguna Woods and has been there for approximately 7 years.

Buechler reviewed the statements she made during the criminal interview, an itemized list of her DR reports (68 cases), and the reports to accompany the list. I asked Buechler if she remembered the statements she made during the criminal investigation. Buechler said everything she said was accurate to the best of her knowledge. I asked Buechler if she wanted to add or change any of the statements she made in that criminal investigation and she said, "No."

I asked Buechler about DRs 16-203093, 16-205670, and 16-220214 where she stated she booked CDs but they were not in evidence. Instead the photographs were embedded in her reports. Buechler thought she was being "ingenious" by embedding the photos into the reports. Buechler thought by embedding the photos into the reports it met the evidentiary requirements. Buechler said she should have written that she embedded the photographs instead of stating she booked them into evidence. Buechler said she didn't know what she did with the CDs but she presumed she had thrown them away.

I asked Buechler about DR 17-015681 where she said she booked in a CD but there was no CD booked into Remedy nor was there any photographs embedded in her report. Buechler said she remembered this case and the victim said he was going to provide her a CD with the photographs. Buechler prepared her report in anticipation of receiving these photographs. Buechler said she believed the victim had dropped the case and never provided the photographs. Buechler submitted the report but left in that she received the photographs in the report. Buechler said it was a mistake and she wasn't trying to hide anything.

I asked Buechler if she used pre-written reports. Buechler said she doesn't have templates, but she does have a standard format of writing reports due to writing the same reports multiple times.

I advised Buechler during the audit it was discovered she had a total 28 cases where she booked evidence late ranging from 3 to 172 days. I asked her if there was any other reasons, other than the ones she already provided during the criminal investigation, why these cases may have been late. Buechler said at times she would hold onto evidence for further investigation. Buechler would also provide evidence to investigators who would book it for her or give it back to her later to be booked in. Buechler said on a couple occasions the evidence was lost for a short time in her work bag.

I asked Buechler out of the 28 cases where she was accused of booking the evidence late, was there any of those cases she wanted to contest. **Note: Buechler was given a table with every case she booked evidence late and the reports associated with those cases.** After reviewing the material, Buechler admitted she booked the evidence in these cases late and she had no valid excuse for doing so.

The following is a brief list of the 28 late booking cases Buechler reviewed. Refer to the provided table for further case details.

I spoke to Buechler about DR 17-022090 where she booked the evidence 39 days late. I advised Buechler that in this case the suspect had plead guilty even though the evidence wasn't booked in. Buechler said she remember this case. Buechler said the evidence had slid down in her bag and she completely forgot about it. Buechler said she found the evidence a few weeks later and immediately booked it. Buechler denied using the evidence for personal use and it was a mistake. Buechler said when the evidence was in her bag, she would transfer the bag to her personal vehicle at the end of the shift. Buechler would then drive the vehicle home and it would be locked in her garage until she went back to work.

I spoke to Buechler about DR 17-016331 where the evidence was booked into Remedy 172 days late. Buechler said she believed she passed this evidence onto investigations without letting them know that the evidence had not been booked yet. Buechler said she was responsible for it and what she wrote in her report wasn't correct. Sgt. Weidenkeller asked Buechler why she didn't document that she passed evidence onto investigators and she said it was an oversight. Buechler understood now what she was doing was wrong and no longer uses this practice.

I asked Buechler about DRs 17-031253 and 17-139035 where evidence was booked in but she didn't document into her reports. Buechler said she had no explanation why this happened but attributed it to an oversight on her part.

I advised Buechler that out of the listed cases, 9 separate occasions evidence was booked under a different login, and 3 times as a "guest." Buechler said about 2 years ago she legally changed her name. The department changed her log information and she couldn't log into Remedy to book evidence. Buechler remembered logging in as guest once because she couldn't use Remedy otherwise.

Buechler said she has booked evidence in when Remedy was already logged in. Buechler was unaware that Remedy kept track of who actually booked in the evidence and she didn't believe it was a big deal who booked the evidence, just that it was booked. Buechler said when she first started using the Remedy system there was no priority on using your own login and she had been booking evidence under this same assumption.

I asked Buechler what her past booking practices were when she booked evidence in. Buechler said when she was trained 22 years ago, and in her past practice, due to being busy, she would collect any evidence and book it in at the end of her shift or at the end of the week. Buechler said she knows now she was wrong and has since corrected that practice. Buechler said before this investigation she didn't believe she was doing it wrong but has come to realize that her practices of booking in evidence were incorrect. Buechler said she now books evidence immediately.

I asked Buechler if she knew the department's policy on booking evidence prior to this investigation and she said she didn't but she knows policy now. Buechler said she has changed for the better since the start of this investigation to now. Buechler said she would book evidence when the opportunity arose. Buechler said there was no excuse for handling the evidence in this way and she was doing it wrong.

At 1014 hours we took a break and we returned 1018.

I asked Buechler if she could explain how she booked evidence now. Buechler said she takes herself out of service and she immediately books evidence using Remedy. Buechler said she never received permission to

hold onto evidence and understood the serious issues when not immediately booking in evidence. (DA, Chain of Custody, Contamination).

I had Buechler read policy following policies out loud; Canon of Ethic 1001.2, Policy 1019.11, Policy 1018.5, Field Operations Manual 19(v)(c)(4). Buechler said she believed she violated these policy but she didn't intend to violate them. Buechler said knowing what she knows now, she would have been more thorough in detailing her reports regarding evidence and book the evidence in a timely manner. I asked Buechler if there was anything else she would like to add. Buechler said she takes full responsibility and she will follow department policy when booking evidence.

2. All narcotics evidence, with the exception of plant material, must be packaged in a ziplock or heat sealed plastic bag of appropriate size. All primary packaging (baggie, bindle, paper, ziplock) must be contained in at least one additional (sealed) plastic bag. The evidence is then sealed in an envelope.
 - a. All evidence suspected to contain fentanyl or suspected toxic material must be contained in at least two plastic bags.
 - b. All large item cases of 400 grams or more, including kilos, must be in plastic ziplock or heat sealed bags prior to placement in boxes or bags.
 - c. If fentanyl or a similar toxic substance is suspected, it must be documented on the evidence packaging whenever possible.
3. Never package fresh marijuana, plant material, perishable items, damp or blood stained clothes in plastic. These items will mold in plastic.
4. Do NOT book perishable food products into property unless the item is needed in a serious criminal investigation requiring bite mark examination or for DNA evidence. In those circumstances, the evidence can be collected and delivered directly to the Central Property/Evidence Office located at 320 N. Flower St. in Santa Ana and secured in the evidence freezer. After normal business hours (Monday through Friday, 0700-1700 hours), this type of evidence can be collected by ID or the Crime Lab to be secured in their freezer pending examination.
5. Securely attach evidence tag and bar code label after entering required case information into P.E.A.B.I.T.S. (Property/Evidence Automated Booking Information Tracking System) located at the nearest Property/Evidence temporary lockers. Exceptions would be if the system is down, or if items are seized pursuant to a search warrant. Under those circumstances, deputies or investigators will be allowed to use standard hard evidence tags to document and collect evidence.
6. Place packaged evidence into lockers, carefully, using caution not to damage it or other items in the locker. Temporary lockers and automated booking systems are located at the following facilities:
 - a. Central Property/Evidence Office (320 N Flower St., Santa Ana)
 - b. Stanton Station (11100 Cedar St., Stanton)

- b. If you have enough space, put the date, time and DR number.

E. Preservation

1. The item should be packaged in such a manner that it will not be damaged or altered during handling.
2. The evidence package must be sealed at the closure. A package is considered "properly sealed" only if its contents cannot readily escape, and only if entering the package results in obvious damage/alteration to the package or its seal.
3. A seal is best accomplished by taping the closure with "non-removable" clear adhesive tape provided at each evidence booking location, and marking the seal with the date and initials of the person collecting the item.
 - a. Paper bags can be sealed by folding the open end over, then taping the folded end to the body of the bag.
 - b. Plastic bags should be sealed like paper bags, but should also be secured with staples, as tape alone may be removed from the plastic. If a plastic bag is used, secure the bag within a larger paper bag for evidence storage. NOTE: When booking narcotics, the potential to "Lose" powders or crystalline material exists if the plastic bag is not sealed correctly. You will utilize a ziplock bag OR heat sealer that is located at the booking location.
 - c. Jars, cans, boxes, tubes, etc. can be sealed after closing by taping over the top and around the body. These storage containers should also be secured with a larger paper bag for evidence storage. Exception: large boxes that are dated and initialed by the person collecting the item(s) at the taped seals.

F. Evidence Packaging (see also Section 44, Tagging and Booking Property)

1. Evidence packaging may be a variety of containers (paper bags, envelopes, tubes, cans, jars, or boxes), but should be appropriate for the nature and size of the evidence. However, the outer evidence package should not be any smaller than a 6"x9" envelope. Money, drugs, weapons, and ammunition shall not be packaged together or with any other evidence. These items are each packaged separately. Large items that need to be processed for fingerprints, but cannot be packaged (e.g. a bicycle, etc.), should be wrapped in brown butcher paper and marked for fingerprint examination.

- e. Field personnel should not attempt to collect evidence if there is:
 - i. Unidentified, loose substances suspected of containing fentanyl.
 - ii. Any quantity of loose or unpackaged substance(s) suspected or known to be narcotics.
 - iii. Any quantity of loose or unpackaged substance(s) that are not known and/or not identifiable, and
 - iv. Any quantity of loose or unpackaged pills containing or suspected of containing fentanyl.
 - v. Field Supervisors shall respond to these types of calls and notify the Narcotics Detail.
 - f. Do NOT transport fentanyl or suspected toxic material without first ensuring proper packaging.
 - g. Fentanyl and suspected toxic material/substances should be transported in trunks of patrol vehicles or in the furthest part of the vehicle compartment away from deputies.
4. Once you have collected the item, retain physical control over it until it is booked in the evidence locker. Property and evidence WILL be secured in an authorized Property/Evidence locker by the end of shift. (Placing items in an employee locker or in your personal vehicle for temporary storage is strictly prohibited). Under extenuating circumstances, a supervisor may authorize temporary storage in an authorized secure area (example: locked office safe, closet or file cabinet) if that area is only accessible by the deputy or the supervisor. This will maintain chain of custody.
- a. If fentanyl or suspected toxic material is collected, that evidence must be transported and booked as soon as practical into the evidence lockers at the Brad Gates Building only.

D. Identification

- 1. In order to get evidence admitted into court, it must be identified.
 - a. On most solid objects, mark them with your initials.

2. The evidence is such that it can be collected without ID's/Crime Lab's assistance.
 - a. An instrument used in the commission of the crime.
 - b. Do not handle or unload a firearm if the weapon needs to be examined for fingerprints, if the firing position of the weapon is critical to the case, or if the deputy cannot safely unload the firearm. If ID/Crime Lab is unavailable, the deputy will contact the Watch Commander who will then contact the Property/Evidence supervisor, who will respond to secure the firearm.
- C. Collection
1. The deputy should note and indicate in his report:
 - a. The items collected: Indicate a full description of the item collected, including color, complete name, model and serial numbers, etc.
 - b. The date and time collected.
 - c. Location found: For example, right front pants pocket of suspect; living room floor located at southeast portion of the residence and give the address.
 2. If the item is such that it may contain fingerprints or other evidence, use care not to contaminate it or destroy existing evidence on the object.
 3. If the item is such that it may contain fentanyl or other suspected toxic material/narcotics the following should be done (For further details, refer to Field Operations Advisory 43 (Fentanyl) & 54 (Narcotics testing and collection):
 - a. Appropriate PPE should be worn to include (2) pairs of nitrile gloves, N95 mask, and eye protection.
 - b. DO NOT perform any field presumptive testing unless otherwise authorized (Narcotics detail).
 - c. Do NOT open a sealed container that contains an unknown substance.
 - d. Communicate with other first responders and emergency personnel when unknown or suspected toxic material is present.

- a. Did they get paint, metal, etc., on them from the scene?
- b. Did they cut themselves while climbing through a broken window?

B. Basic search patterns

1. The successful key to searching is to use a method and follow this method once started.
2. Methods
 - a. Strip method: People get on a line and search in one direction.
 1. This is usually used where you have a large crime scene such as an open field, and you have a number of additional deputies.
 - b. Other methods for outdoors are the grid method, zone method, spiral method, and wheel method.
 - c. For the average-sized room indoors, the clockwise method is usually best. You search the entire room in a circular clockwise method.
 - d. Once you have made your search, take a second look.

IV. Other Areas Where Evidence is Found

- A. On the suspect or their environment
- B. On the victim

V. Collection, Identification and Preservation of Evidence

- A. The collection, identification, and preservation of evidence are usually the responsibility of a forensic specialist (ID) or the Crime Lab.
- B. In some instances, the patrol deputy will collect, identify, tag, and book the evidence.
 1. A minor crime where the presence of ID/Crime Lab is not necessary.

EVIDENCE

I. Physical Evidence Defined

- A. Any and all material objects or other things which are located in the course of an investigation which may aid in establishing the identity of a suspect and which can be offered to the court to prove the existence or non-existence of a fact.
 - 1. Training, experience, intuition, and imagination help in determining good physical evidence.

II. Recognizing and Protecting the Crime Scene

- A. When the victim or reporting party enters the crime scene, they usually are unaware a crime has occurred.
 - 1. They may alter or destroy the evidence prior to notifying the Sheriff's Department.
- B. Arrival at the crime scene (Training Bulletin 12-08)
 - 1. Do not touch or move anything.
 - 2. Protect the scene (secure the perimeter and establish a crime scene).
 - 3. Check area to see if the suspect is still present.
 - 4. Identify the points of entry and exit without unnecessary delay.
 - 5. Note everything that is moved and by whom.
 - 6. Make a thorough crime scene search, both inside and outside the crime scene.

III. Crime Scene Search

- A. Look at the scene from two points of view:
 - 1. What did the suspect do at the crime scene?
 - 2. What the crime scene may have done to the suspect.
