**Narrative:**

On Sunday 2-28-16, I was working uniformed patrol in the City of San Clemente, County of Orange, California. At about 1910 hours, Deputy [REDACTED] and I were dispatched to 1750 Avenida Estacion (North Beach) reference a male without a shirt and blue jeans was jumping onto the railroad tracks and confronting people in the parking lot of the beach. Upon arrival, I contacted [REDACTED] in the parking lot of North Beach. [REDACTED] stated the male we are looking for was named Joshua and Joshua had punched him in the head 2 times and kicked him in the back. [REDACTED] wife (NFD) ran up the beach area because she was scared of Joshua. After Deputy [REDACTED] arrived, I checked the railroad tracks near the train station. While next to the tracks, a male stated the subject we are looking for is on the life guard station platform near the bathroom on North Beach.

Deputy [REDACTED] and I went the beach access area near the life guard tower. I could see a male, later identified as Joshua Michelle Miles [REDACTED] without a shirt wearing blue jeans on the life guard tower. As Deputy [REDACTED] and I walked to the beach from the beach access, Miles was on the beach standing near the life guard tower. Miles appeared agitated and was pacing back and forth as he was talking out loud to himself. I asked Miles to walk over to me and he started to comply by walking to the rocky area which would have been difficult to climb over the rocks. I then pointed to the ramp area which is the pathway to and from the beach area. Miles than stated that was not going to walk to the ramp area where I pointed to. Deputy [REDACTED] and I walked towards using the access ramp. Once we reached to the bottom of the ramp, I asked Miles again to walk over to us. Miles complied. Since Miles was agitated, pacing, talking to himself and a person already stated he was punched in the head by Miles just prior to our arrival, I asked Miles to place his hands behind him back so I could place handcuffs on Miles for my safety and his.

I gained control of Miles' hands and Deputy [REDACTED] grabbed his handcuffs. As Miles heard the click of the handcuffs, Miles verbalized he did not want to be handcuffed. At that same time, Miles broke his


hand free from my grip and attempted to flee. I grabbed Miles' upper left shoulder and left arm. I attempted to place Miles on the ground but he continued to resist. After a brief struggle, Deputy [REDACTED] and I got Miles on the ground. Deputy [REDACTED] via radio called out a 960 X-ray, which means all available patrol units in the area to respond with lights and siren to our location immediately. Miles then swung his left elbow in a backwards motion striking me in the chest area. Miles then tucked his left arm under his chest to prevent us from handcuffing him. Right after Miles struck me in the chest, I punched Miles in the upper left torso with my right hand. While continuing to give Miles verbal commands to stop resisting and place his hands behind his back, Miles clinched both his arms together under his chest. I then took control of Miles's upper torso and head area. Miles continued to resist by kicking a flailing about on the ground with his hands under his body. Deputy [REDACTED] arrived to assist. I applied the carotid control hold on Miles. After a few moments, Miles lost consciousness. I held the carotid control hold for ten seconds after Miles was rendered unconscious. After I released the hold, Deputies [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] took control of Miles' hand and placed them behind his back. They got one handcuff on his right hand and Miles gained consciousness. A struggle ensued again but Miles was finally handcuffed. The overall duration of Miles' attempt to flee and resist Deputies while legally attempting to detain him was about three minutes.

During the struggle with Miles, Miles struck Deputy [REDACTED] in the chest area with his right elbow. See Deputy [REDACTED] follow-up report for further details, this DR. Also during the struggle, the left side of my patrol uniform shirt was ripped. I later booked my uniform shirt into evidence.

Once Miles was handcuffed and search, Miles was allowed to sit up on the ground. He was alert and responsive. Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) was requested to respond to our location. Miles was escorted off the beach area and to my patrol vehicle.

I contacted [REDACTED] who was still on scene. [REDACTED] stated he was at a fire pit on North Beach when "Joshua" approached him. [REDACTED] gave him some food. Joshua started to get angry and threatened him and his wife. Joshua yell, "What to fuck. I'll hit you, just hit me first." In attempt to get Joshua to go away, [REDACTED] gave him \$5.00. Joshua then slapped and punched [REDACTED] in the back of the head. As [REDACTED] walked away, Joshua Kicked him in the back. [REDACTED] does not want prosecution and does not want any trouble with Joshua again.

While waiting for OCFA to arrive, Miles became agitated and started to flail while Deputies were holding him. Miles than was placed in the back of my patrol vehicle. Miles than started to kick the door

windows and bang his head against the interior window. Due to Miles being combative again, OCFA was canceled and I immediately drove Miles to San Clemente Hospital to be medically evaluated.


Miles was medically treated at San Clemente Hospital for scraps and abrasions to his face, both elbows and both knees. Miles was given a bandage for his left big toe because his toe nail was bend backwards and the nurse removed the toe nail. Miles was medically cleared for booking by MD D. Hsieh.

Due to the facts Miles attempted to flee from us as we were detaining him, he struck both Deputy [REDACTED] and I in the chest area with his elbow while resisting, I suffered an injury to my right wrist, I told Miles he was under arrest for CPC 69-Resist or Deter an Officer, CPC 148(a)(1)-Delay an Officer, CPC 241(c)-Battery on a Peace Officer and CPC 243(b)-Assault on a Peace Officer.

Miles was booking into the Orange County Jail for the above charges; Bkn. #2927102.

I request prosecution for the following charges:

- CPC 69-Resist or Deter an Officer
- CPC 148(a)(1)-Delay an Officer
- CPC 241(c)-Battery on a Peace Officer
- CPC 243(b)-Assault on a Peace Officer

Upon arrival, Deputies [REDACTED] and Page had been in a physical altercation with Joshua Micheallee Miles [REDACTED]. For further details see Deputy Page's report this DR#. I assisted Deputy [REDACTED] and escorted Joshua to Deputy Page's patrol unit.

At 1945 hours I arrived at the San Clemente Hospital. While at the San Clemente Hospital, I assisted medical staff with placing leg restraints on Joshua.

12. DETAILS OF OFFENSE:

On Sunday 2-28-16, I was working uniformed patrol in the City of San Clemente in the County of Orange. At about 1915 hours, I responded to 1750 Avenida Estacion to assist Deputy S. Page #1127 and Deputy [REDACTED]. Deputy [REDACTED] had used his radio to request for additional deputies to respond.

I arrived and observed Deputy [REDACTED] and Deputy Page struggling on the ground with a male subject later identified as Joshua Michaellee Miles [REDACTED]. As Miles was turned over I placed my knee on his upper back to control him while he was placed in handcuffs. I continued to use my bodyweight to control Miles while he attempted to stand up and lift his upper body off of the ground. Miles was eventually controlled and transported to San Clemente Hospital.

While at the hospital, I used my hands on multiple occasions to control Miles' legs from kicking the hospital staff. After Miles was medically cleared for jail booking, he was transported and booked into the Intake Release Center.

12. DETAILS OF OFFENSE:

On 2-28-16, I was working uniform patrol in the City of San Clemente. At approximately 1856 hours, I was dispatched to 1750 Avd Estacion to assist Deputy S. Page #1127 on a call reference a male subject jumping onto the railroad tracks and confronting people in the parking lot.

Deputy Page and I arrived and I saw a male subject later identified as Joshua Michaelle Miles [REDACTED] standing on the beach and without a shirt. Miles appeared to be very agitated and was not making any sense. Deputy Page contacted Miles and instructed him to place both hands behind his back. Miles complied. As Miles placed both hands behind his back, he spontaneously said he was not going to comply and jerked away from Deputy Page. I immediately grabbed Miles' right wrist and elbow in an attempt to gain control. Miles began to pull his right hand away from me in an aggressive manner. I assisted Deputy Page in placing Miles to the ground by grabbing his right shoulder and pushing him to the ground. Using my hand held radio, I called out a 960-X-ray, which means all available patrol units in the area to respond with lights and sirens to our location. While on the ground, Miles violently struck me with his right elbow to my chest area and began to flail his arm in an aggressive manner. I gave him commands to place his hands behind his back but Miles did not comply. Unknown if Miles had any weapons on him, to prevent him from assaulting Deputy Page and in an attempt to gain control of him, I struck Miles about 3 times on the right side of his body with my right hand. Miles immediately pulled his right arm underneath him. Deputy Page applied the Carotid at which point I was able to gain control of his right wrist and elbow. Deputy [REDACTED] arrived and assisted in placing handcuffs on Miles. Sgt. Carpenter arrived on scene.

Miles was transported to San Clemente Hospital (654 Camino De Los Mares) by Deputy S. Page and I followed.

12. DETAILS OF OFFENSE:

## Supervisor's Summary:

Deputy S. Page #1127 and Deputy [REDACTED] were dispatched to the North Beach area reference a suspicious male. Deputy Page speaks to (W) [REDACTED] who gives him a description of a male subject he claimed had assaulted him, and told him "the guy" he was looking for was on the Lifeguard tower. Deputy Page walked toward the tower near the bathroom building and saw the male subject matching the description given by the tower. Deputy Page recognized (S)MILES from previous contacts and at least one prior use of force incident involving Deputy D. Zill #5141 and Deputy G. Coffee #3605. Deputy Page asked (S)MILES to walk over to him and, after asking several times, (S)MILES complied. Due to (S)MILES reported behavior, the earlier assault, and prior knowledge of the use of force incident, Deputy Page decided to handcuff (S)MILES before talking to him or searching him. When (S)MILES heard the "click" of the handcuffs he said he was not going to be handcuffed and tried to run away. Deputy Page grabbed onto (S)MILES' left side and arm while Deputy [REDACTED] grabbed his right side and arm and tried to take (S)MILES to the ground. (S)MILES began using his elbows to strike the deputies and then pulled both arms underneath his upper body and started to kick at the Deputies. Both Deputies tried using body strikes to gain control of (S)MILES' hands but were unable to control them. Deputy Page applied the Carotid Control Hold and when (S)MILES lost consciousness he attempted to get both hands in handcuffs. (S)MILES regained consciousness and Deputy [REDACTED] arrived and used his bodyweight on top of (S)MILES to assist Deputy Page in gaining control of, and handcuffing, both hands.

(S)MILES continued to be uncooperative and kept kicking at the deputies until he was placed in the rear seat of the patrol car. Once inside he started kicking the windows and hitting his head on the center seat divider. I requested Deputy Page drive (S)MILES directly to San Clemente Hospital for treatment and observation due to the application of the Carotid Control Hold. He was followed by Deputy [REDACTED], Deputy [REDACTED] and Deputy J. Buraglia #7745. (S)MILES was still uncooperative at the hospital and after being placed in a bed in Room #8, deputies assisted in holding his legs and torso until soft restraints could be applied by the nursing staff. After (S)MILES received the necessary treatment he was transported to the IRC and booked for the listed charges.

During the altercation Deputy Page struck or smashed his right hand on the pavement of the walkway near the bathrooms at North Beach, and originally complained of pain and a minor bit of swelling. The next day he returned to
