Notification Summary:

On 3-24-17, Deputy [REDACTED] and Deputy G. Dorado were working as members of the OCSO [REDACTED]. At about 1855 hrs, they saw Erik Manuel Villegas ([REDACTED]) standing in the alleyway behind [REDACTED] in SJC. Villegas is a Varrio Viejo gang member and had a warrant. Deputy [REDACTED] and Deputy Dorado contacted Villegas. Deputy [REDACTED] told Villegas to put his hands behind his back. Villegas complied. Villegas immediately pulled away and tried to run down the alley. Deputy [REDACTED] attempted to stop Villegas from running. Villegas turned around and swung at Deputy [REDACTED] hitting him in the face. Deputy [REDACTED] and Deputy Dorado took Villegas to the ground. On the ground, Villegas swung at Deputy [REDACTED] and Deputy Dorado. Villegas reached for his abdomen attempting to retrieve an unknown object. Fearing Villegas was reaching for a weapon, Deputy Dorado punched Villegas in the face. Villegas continued to resist and refused to obey Deputy [REDACTED] commands. Deputy [REDACTED] and Deputy Dorado continued hitting Villegas and requested additional units. Deputy [REDACTED] and Deputy Dorado used their body weight to control Villegas. SJC Deputies arrived at the location and they were able to handcuff Villegas. As a result of the altercation, Deputy [REDACTED] and Deputy Dorado suffered injuries to their hands. They were treated at Mission Hospital. Worker's Comp paperwork was completed. Villegas was arrested for CPC 69, CPC 243(c)(1), CPC 135, CPC 11364, and the warrant.

Comments from the Captain:

No further action required. The Use of Force was within policy.
