## NARRATIVE

On Tuesday (12-3-19) the Honorable Judge Kevin J. Haskins, at West Justice Center W16 authorized a search warrant commanding any Law Enforcement Officer to obtain the GPS precision location information for target phone number [REDACTED] with T-Mobile Service Provider. The subject whom I believed to be using the target number was Michael Edward Crane [REDACTED]. Through records checks I conducted, I knew Crane was on probation with terms of search and seizure and had two active felony warrants for his arrest.

On Thursday (12-5-19) I obtained GPS precision information for the target number. Members of the Orange County Sheriff's Department established surveillance in the area of [REDACTED] in the City of Fullerton. At about 1620 hours, Investigator [REDACTED] saw a male open the gate on the east side of the residence. Investigator [REDACTED] saw a motorcycle leave the residence and described the male as wearing a red and grey shirt with a black vest and grey pants. The male was described as wearing a black helmet with a white helmet attached to the rear of the



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motorcycle. The male drove away east on [REDACTED] Avenue and continued to [REDACTED] Avenue and turned east. The male turned north on [REDACTED] Street and due to traffic we did not see where he travelled.

At about 1655 hours, I obtained GPS precision information for the target number. Members of the Orange County Sheriff's Department established surveillance in the area of [REDACTED] in the City of Fullerton (County of Orange). I arrived and saw the male who matched the description Investigator [REDACTED] provided standing in the street just south of [REDACTED] on the east curb line. The male was carrying his helmet and I could see his face and physical description which matched, Michael Edward Crane [REDACTED] who had two felony warrants for his arrest and who was on probation with terms of search and seizure. As I drove past the location, Crane got onto the motorcycle. Investigator [REDACTED] saw the male with the motorcycle in the driveway of [REDACTED]. Investigator [REDACTED] told me the motorcycle was parked in front of a 1999 white Acura CL 2-door [REDACTED] in the driveway of the residence.

Once other members of the Orange County Sheriff's Department were in position to contact Crane, we drove to the residence. I contacted Crane while wearing my Sheriff's Department green loaded tactical vest with a uniform badge attached to the front and "Sheriff" imprinted on the back in the driveway of the residence. I asked Crane to speak to me away from the motorcycle and he walked towards, Investigator [REDACTED] vehicle. At the same time Investigator [REDACTED] contacted a male later identified as [REDACTED] who was on probation with terms of search and seizure.

As I began to speak to Crane, he told me he was not on probation and I could not search him. I told Crane I was going to remove the knife I could see which was attached to his right front pants pocket and he consented. I asked Crane for his name and he verbally identified himself as [REDACTED]. Due to my identification of the male as Crane, I motioned to Investigator [REDACTED] to handcuff Crane. I held Crane's hands behind his back while I removed the knife from his pants pocket. As Investigator [REDACTED] removed his handcuffs, Crane turned his head and possibly saw the handcuffs.

Crane suddenly pulled his hands apart from my grasp. I grabbed and attempted to control Crane's right arm using a control hold while Investigator [REDACTED] attempted to control Crane's left arm. Crane was moving both arms attempting to break free from my grasp. I told Crane to stop resisting several times and I told him to relax. Investigator [REDACTED] arrived and attempted to hold Crane against our vehicle. Crane began moving his body and legs in an attempt to break free. I told Crane if he did not stop we would have to take him to the ground. Crane continued moving his body, arms and legs so body weight was used to force Crane to the ground. Once on the ground, I controlled Crane's right arm with a firm grip and used my body weight on his upper back. After a short period of time, we were able to place Crane in handcuffs.

I saw Crane had blood on his face, so I requested Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) respond to our location to evaluate Crane. While waiting for OCFA to respond to the scene, I again asked Crane for his name. Crane responded by again verbally identifying himself as [REDACTED] and provided me with a date of birth [REDACTED]. I conducted a records check which revealed [REDACTED] was a real person and I obtained the Department of Motor Vehicles photograph of [REDACTED]. I attempted



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to show Crane the photograph but Crane would not look at me. I conducted a search of Crane's wallet and found a credit card with Crane's name on it. I also found a Wells Fargo Debit card account number [REDACTED] in the name of [REDACTED] a MasterCard account number [REDACTED] in the name of [REDACTED] and a Victoria Secret credit card number [REDACTED] in the name of [REDACTED]. I told Crane I knew who he was and told him to be honest. Crane refused to speak to me.

OCFA and Care ambulance arrived and determined Crane needed further medical treatment. Investigator [REDACTED] rode in the ambulance with Crane as he was transported to St. Jude Hospital located at 101 East Valencia Mesa Drive in the City of Fullerton.

I conducted a records check of the motorcycle using the Vehicle Identification Number on the frame of the motorcycle, [REDACTED]. The records check revealed the 2016 Harley Davidson motorcycle was reported as stolen on (11-16-19) from San Diego County Sheriff's Department area under [REDACTED]. I attempted to contact the registered owner of the motorcycle, [REDACTED] on his cell phone [REDACTED]. I was unable to contact [REDACTED] and left a message on his voicemail. I towed the motorcycle pursuant to CVC 22653(a) - Stolen Vehicle Private Property. The motorcycle was towed by Pacific Towing (714-538-2001) to 2840 East Coronado in the City of Anaheim.

I conducted a search of the motorcycle and found a black pouch attached to the front of the motorcycle which contained an unused syringe and several unused plastic baggies. I also found a black helmet with the writing, "Fuck Shit Up" written on the back in black marker. Based on my training and experience, I know Fuck Shit Up (FSU) is a criminal street gang in the City of Huntington Beach. I also know Crane to be a member of the criminal street gang who uses the moniker, "Whitey."

Investigator [REDACTED] conducted a probation search of [REDACTED] vehicle, the white Acura. During the search, Investigator [REDACTED] found a used methamphetamine pipe and a plastic Ziploc style baggie with a few pieces of presumptive methamphetamine inside. I examined the pipe and determined the pipe was an illegal drug pipe used to ingest substances such as methamphetamine. I examined the baggie and it appeared to contain remnant methamphetamine. I collected both items as evidence.

I spoke to [REDACTED] about the incident. I read [REDACTED] his Miranda Rights from a department issued Miranda warning card. [REDACTED] answered, "Yes" to each of the four advisements and agreed to speak to me. Below is a summary of [REDACTED] statements:

[REDACTED] stated the baggie was his but it contained sugar and not methamphetamine. [REDACTED] told me the pipe was not his. [REDACTED] claimed he did not know who the pipe belonged to but had people inside of his vehicle whom he would not identify. [REDACTED] admitted he last used methamphetamine about two days prior to our contact. [REDACTED] stated he normally snorts methamphetamine and the last time he smoked methamphetamine was about 12 months prior to our contact. I asked [REDACTED] about the contact we had with Crane. [REDACTED] told me he was facing the house and did not see anything. [REDACTED] explained he heard yelling but did not hear anything specific.

Based on [REDACTED] statements and the evidence collected, I arrested [REDACTED] from H&S 11364(a) - Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. I told [REDACTED] I would be writing a report to the District Attorney



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about the incident. [REDACTED] was released at the scene without incident.

I drove to St. Jude Hospital to speak to Crane about the incident. I arrived and spoke to Crane in the emergency room getting medical treatment. I read Crane his Miranda Rights from a department issued Miranda warning card. Crane answered, "Yes" to each of the four advisements and agreed to speak to me. Below is a summary of Crane's statements:

Crane told me [REDACTED] was one of his best friends for many years. Crane explained he identified himself as [REDACTED] because he thought he had a warrant for his arrest and did not want to go to jail. Crane stated he started a new job and did not want to answer for his warrant. I asked Crane about resisting arrest. Crane explained he did not want to go to jail and he knew once he was handcuffed he would be going to jail. Crane also told me he knew I was with the Sheriff's Department when I contacted him.

I asked Crane about the motorcycle. Crane told me his friend, [REDACTED] let him borrow the motorcycle sometime around Saturday (11-30-19). Crane stated [REDACTED] told him the key to the motorcycle was lost. Crane did not think the motorcycle was stolen because [REDACTED] had several motorcycles. Crane admitted the motorcycle had been in his possession since Saturday (11-30-19).

I asked Crane about the Victoria Secret Credit Card found inside of his wallet. Crane told me he thought it was a gift card. Crane explained about seven to ten days prior to our contact a black male gave him the card. Crane told me he was given the card at a Circle K on Harbor Boulevard in the City of Fullerton. Crane stated he gave the male \$10.00 and that the male just gave him the card.

I asked Crane about the Wells Fargo Visa Debit Card. Crane told me he found the Wells Fargo card and the MasterCard on in the driveway of a residence located on the corner of Slater and Jefferson in the City of Huntington Beach. Crane explained he found both cards about four months prior to our contact. Crane stated he asked people inside of the residence if the cards belonged to them and no one knew who the cards belonged to. I asked Crane why he did not report finding the cards to law enforcement and he told me he did not report it to law enforcement because he had a warrant for his arrest.

I remained at the hospital until Crane received medical treatment. Crane was medically cleared from the hospital and I requested Deputy Z. Bieker #7425 transport Crane to the jail. Deputy Bieker arrived and transported Crane to Orange County Jail where he was booked for his felony warrants without incident.

Based on the evidence collected and statements gathered at the scene. I arrested Crane for his active warrants, PC 496D(a) - Possession of Stolen Motorcycle, PC 529(a)(3) - Falsely Identify to make Other Liable, PC 148(a)(1) - Resist / Obstruct / Delay Peace Officer and PC 530.5 - Identity Theft. I served Crane a Notice of Determination notice. Crane admitted to being a member of FSU who went by the moniker, "Whitey". Crane told me he was violently assaulted for 23 seconds in 2004 as an initiation into FSU and has been a member since. Crane explained the significance of the number 23, "W" is the 23rd letter of the alphabet and is meant to stand for white. Crane told me he was given the moniker, Whitey by family members during his childhood. Crane stated he was in good standing with FSU.



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I forwarded the information pertaining to the credit cards to Economic Crimes for further follow-up. For further details on the credit cards see Investigator Sakamoto's Follow-up report under this same DR#. I took several digital photographs of the vehicle and of Crane as evidence. I also recorded the interviews of Crane and [REDACTED]. All photographs and interviews were later placed onto a CD for evidence.

I gave Crane verbal notice of the search warrant during the time of his arrest. All evidence was collected and later booked into the Orange County Sheriff's Evidence Lockers located in the City of Santa Ana. A request was submitted to the Orange County Crime Lab to have the presumptive methamphetamine scientifically tested and weighed.

On Monday (12-9-19) I contacted [REDACTED] who was the owner of the Harley Davidson motorcycle. [REDACTED] told me he did not give Crane permission to be in possession of the motorcycle and did not know Crane. [REDACTED] told me the value of the Harley Davidson motorcycle was about \$18,000.00. I gave [REDACTED] verbal notification of where the motorcycle was towed.

## NARRATIVE

On 12-5-19 I was working at as a plain clothes Investigator with the Orange County Sheriff's Department Special Operations detail. At about 1655 hours, I was assisting Orange County Sheriff's North Gang enforcement Team Deputy [REDACTED] and other members of the Special Operations detail with locating a wanted probationer identified as Michael Edward Crane [REDACTED] (CRANE). We located CRANE and followed him to [REDACTED] in the City of Fullerton. We then attempted to detain CRANE in the driveway of the residence. I exited my vehicle while wearing my department issued Sheriff's Department external outer carrier green vest and identified verbally identified myself as law enforcement. Deputy [REDACTED] and Investigator [REDACTED] attempted to detain CRANE at the apron of the driveway, behind one of our vehicles while Investigator [REDACTED] detained an additional subject who was speaking with CRANE in the driveway. I, along with Sgt. [REDACTED] covered the front of the residence because we could hear yelling inside.

While covering the residence, I could hear a verbal commotion in the area where Deputy [REDACTED] was attempting to detain CRANE. I looked over and heard Deputy [REDACTED] ordering CRANE to place his hands behind his back, but it appeared CRANE was refusing to do so. I walked over to assist them in handcuffing CRANE and he began struggling more. CRANE continued to attempt to pull his hands away so I placed my forearm over his shoulders to keep his upper body pinned to the rear trunk of the vehicle. CRANE continued to disregard multiple orders to stop resisting and continued to actively resist by pulling his hands away from the arresting Deputies. Deputy [REDACTED] then requested we take CRANE to the ground to gain control of his resistant behavior. I assisted by holding CRANE'S upper body around his shoulders and placing him on the ground with my body weight. I then placed my knee between CRANE'S shoulder blades to keep him from moving off the ground and assisted Deputy [REDACTED] in handcuffing CRANE.

After he was handcuffed I noticed CRANE was bleeding from the nose. Deputy [REDACTED] requested paramedics respond and I placed him on his side in the recovery position while waiting for them to respond.

## NARRATIVE

I was assigned this report D/R 19-046455 written by Deputy [REDACTED] for follow up investigation. I was tasked with contacting the card holders for the three credit cards found in Crane's wallet. (For further details refer to D/R 19-046455)

**Wells Fargo Credit Card:**

On 12/09/19, I spoke with [REDACTED] by telephone and what follows is a summary of the conversation.

[REDACTED] told me he lost his Wells Fargo Debit card and ordered a replacement card. He stated he was still waiting for the replacement card to arrive in the mail.

He stated he did not know Michael Edward Crane [REDACTED] nor did Crane have permission to have the Wells Fargo debit card in his possession. [REDACTED] did not desire prosecution of Crane.

I was unable to speak to the other owners of the cards found at the scene.

**Ann Taylor Credit Card**

On 12/30/19, I spoke to [REDACTED] who told me the following. What follows is a summary of the conversation.

[REDACTED] told me she requested the Ann Taylor Credit card around November 26 or 27th, 2019. She never received the credit card in the mail.

She told me she did not know [REDACTED] or Michael Crane ([REDACTED]). [REDACTED] stated Crane did not have her permission to have the Ann Taylor card in his possession. She desires prosecution in this matter.

**Victoria Secret credit card**

I was unable to [REDACTED] regarding her Victoria Secret credit card found at the scene.

NARRATIVE

I am an Investigator assigned to the Special Operations detail within the Special Investigations Bureau. On 12-5-19, my partners and I were assisting Deputy [REDACTED] and the North Gang Enforcement Team with locating wanted subject Michael Crane [REDACTED]. I was given a physical description and viewed photographs of Crane prior to the surveillance.

On 12-5-19, at about 1655 hours, we went to [REDACTED] in the city of Fullerton. As I arrived, Deputy [REDACTED] and Investigator [REDACTED] were already approaching on foot. I joined Deputy [REDACTED] who was already talking to a subject in the driveway of the residence. As I got closer, I could see the person Deputy [REDACTED] was talking to was wanted subject Michael Crane. I followed Deputy [REDACTED] and Crane as they moved toward Investigator [REDACTED] car.

I could hear Deputy [REDACTED] asking Crane about his probation status and identity. Crane lied about his name and denied being on probation. Deputy [REDACTED] asked Crane to put his hands behind his back so he remove the knife from Crane's pocket. Crane put his hands behind his back, but continued to say he was not on probation. Deputy [REDACTED] was holding Cranes hands while he removed the knife from Cranes pocket. I removed my handcuffs and stood next to Deputy [REDACTED] waiting for an opportunity to place handcuffs on Crane. Deputy [REDACTED] motioned for me to handcuff Crane. As Deputy [REDACTED] moved over a bit to give me room, I heard Deputy [REDACTED] ask Crane to not pull his hands away. I could see separation in Cranes hands as I tried to handcuff Crane. I grabbed Crane by the left arm and tried to keep it behind his back. Crane continued to pull his left arm toward the front of his body. I told Crane to put his hands behind his back, but he refused. I put my handcuffs away and used both hands to bring his left arm behind him in a control hold. Investigator [REDACTED] joined us in an attempt to maintain control of Crane. Despite multiple commands, Crane was still trying to break free. Deputy [REDACTED] Investigator [REDACTED] and I used our body weight to take him to the ground. While on the ground, I used my body weight on his legs to prevent him from standing and to keep him from kicking. Eventually, we were able to handcuff Crane.

Crane appeared to be bleeding from his nose. OC Fire Authority responded for medical treatment. I followed Deputy [REDACTED] and Crane in the ambulance to St Judes hospital for further treatment.
